

Park Jefferson Speedway Push Truck Rules

Push and tow trucks are a necessary part of every racing event at the Park Jefferson Speedway. We will require all push truck drivers to agree and abide by the following rules and regulations. Failure to follow the rules will result in temporary or even permanent suspension of the privileges!

All drivers need to register by filling out an application. Each push truck is allowed 2 Adults per event. Tow trucks will also be permitted 2 people per event. All individuals must sign in at the pit gate at the same time to receive their complimentary pit passes. Any attempt to try and get in more than two people per truck for free will result in instant and permanent revocation of your push truck privileges. All push truck drivers must remain with their truck for the duration of the racing event. Push truck drivers are NOT allowed to work on a race team pit crew. 1st offense you will asked to leave that evening. 2nd offense you will be asked to leave the pit area and not allowed to push for the remainder of the season.

- All working push trucks and tow trucks should be checked in a minimum of ½ hour prior to the beginning of hot laps. If you do not plan to work, please do not sign in for the complimentary passes.
- You should never take any chances or pull onto the racing surface under green flag conditions.
- Your helper should remain in the truck at all times. No one is permitted to ride in the bed of the truck at any time. This will be strictly enforced.
- All push and tow trucks should be ready to help roll the track in at any time when asked.
- Reckless driving will not be tolerated. Act professionally at all times.
- Alcoholic beverages and/or usage of, will not be permitted in pit area/restricted area at any time during or before the racing event.
- In the event of a red flag situation, do not attempt to go to the scene of the accident until directed by a race official or safety crew member. Failure to abide by the rule will result in suspension to your privileges.
- Emergency lights on the roof are recommended but not required. All lights must remain off during green flag conditions.
- Park Jefferson management will be keeping a roster of drivers. We will be capping the number of push trucks to 8 per night.
- Only push a car onto the track when directed. Do not push a car during a red flag situation unless directed by an official to push to the work area.
- All push and tow trucks are required to have scanners/2 way radios.
